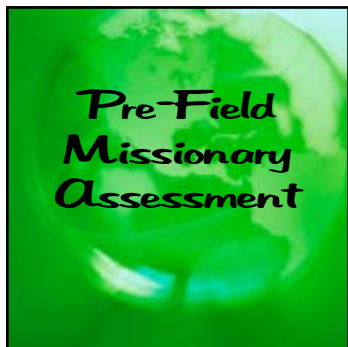

International Ministerial Fellowship (IMF) is committed to preparing its missionaries for long term service around the world. In our quest to develop a comprehensive training program, we recognize the need for pre-qualification of our mission candidates as a prerequisite for acceptance in the missions department.

To that end, we have established alliances with assessment centers (AC) to handle this process. Upon completion, the AC will provide a recommendation to the IMF Missions Committee.

### Assessment Centers

The AC we use are interdenominational organizations, providing renewal, counseling and consultation, designed to minister to the needs of Christian leaders.

### Who needs to attend?

Those wishing to apply for service with the IMF Missions Department need to visit an AC. The candidate along with their spouse (if married) must complete the assessment program prior to acceptance into the IMF Missions Department.

### Assessment Program Outline

The process begins with an inventory of psychological, emotional, personality and relational instruments administered by the AC. These tools, along with interviews with professional counselors will be used to help assess your potential success as a missionary. The AC will then make recommendations to you and International Ministerial Fellowship regarding your preparation for the mission field. This process may require as much as two days at the AC.
